- 6. Fill out application and return by July 15th. All renewal application and dues not received by July 15th will by subject to a five (5) dollar late fee.
- 7. At least one family representative will attend the ANNUAL MEETING.
- 8. To be legally home educating your children by registering with the state in an approved accountability association, SCAIHS, or your school district.

## STATEMENT OF FAITH
